## <u>Blessed Daudi Okelo and Jildo Irwa</u> <u>Catechists and Martyrs</u>

The story of the precious lives of these young Ugandan martyrs is not well-known. These lay catechists were so young Ugandan martyrs is not well-known. These lay catechists were so young that we could correctly regard them as children, excerpt for the fact that both children voluntarily walked into martyrdom. Both young men belonged to the Acholi tribe and were catechized by the Comboni Missionaries in 1915.

Daudi Okelo was born around 1902 to pagan parents in the village of Ogom-Payira. He received Christian instruction and baptism around age fourteen an immediately wanted to be a catechist. He could not wait to tell others about his new faith. In 917 the local catechist died and Daudi petitioned the local priest, Father Cesare Gambaretto, for the position. He was ready to get started so Father Cesare assigned the young Jildo Irwa as his assistant.

Jildo Irwa was born around 1902 to pagan parents (his father would embrace the Catholic faith later) in the village of Bar-Kitoba. He was baptized by Father Cesae June 6, 1916, at about the age of ten. He and Daudi were confirmed on the same day, October 15, 1916.

December is Safe Toys and Gifts Month Prevent Blindness America suggests: • Make recommendations to family members and friends about gifts that you feel are appropriate for your child. Be diligent about inspecting these gifts before allowing your child to play with them. • Inspect all toys before purchasing. Monitor toys that your child has received as gifts to make sure they are appropriate for your child's age and developmental level. • For younger children, avoid play sets with small magnets and make sure batteries are secured within the toy. If magnets or batteries are ingested, serious injuries and/or death can occur. • Gifts of sports equipment should always be accompanied by protective gear (such as a basketball along with eye goggles or a face guard with a new batting helmet for baseball or softball). • Any toy that is labeled "supervision required" must always be used in the presence of an adult. Keep toys meant for older children away from younger ones. • Always save the warranties and directions for every toy. If possible, include a gift receipt. Repair or throw away damaged toys. • Avoid toys that shoot or include parts that fly off. • Inspect toys for sturdiness. Your child's toys should be durable, with no sharp edges or points. The toys should also withstand impact. Dispose of plastic wrapping material immediately on toys as they may have sharp edges. • Don't give toys with small parts to young children. Young kids tend to put things in their mouths, increasing the risk of choking. If the part of a toy can fit in a toilet paper roll, the toy is not appropriate for children under the age of 3.
