Pope of Peace ~ **Pope Saint Miltiades** The Thirty-Second Pope

Pope Miltiades (also known as Melchiades) served as pope during a time of peace that followed Emperor Constantine's end to the persecution of Christians in the Roman Empire. How significant for Miltiades, as African pope, to occupy the papacy at this time. One of the problems he did have to deal with, however, was the split caused by the Donatist (led by Donatus, who taught that sacraments performed by lapsed priests needed to be redone). This split proved to be a major issue in the African church due to changes leveled against Caecilian, the new bishop of Carthage (in present-day Tunisia).

The Donatist, convinced they were right, intensely argued for new sacraments. Their positions caused quite the stir, as now the church needed to address whether grace, once issued, can be taken back. The Donatists believed that grace were never given, since sinful priests made the sacraments invalid. It was as if the sacraments never took place—all empty gestures, as far as they were concerned.

Miltiades answered this dilemma by ruling that all sacraments were valid and could not be redone and that the worthiness of a priest was not an issue.


