The Energetic Saint – Pope Saint Gelasius I The 49th Pope

Saint Gelasius was certainly a busy pope. He is one of the three African pope in the early church. At the time of his papacy he was second only to Leo I in terms of his papal activities. Additionally, Gelasius inherited the Acacian schism as he ascended the papacy in the year 492. This split involved the patriarch Acacius of Constantinople who appointed Monophysite bishops (believing that Christ's humanity was swallowed up by his divinity). These new bishops did not support the Catholic doctrine that Jesus was fully human and fully divine.

The bishops' appointment was unacceptable to Gelasius. He continued to argue this issue even after Acacius died, at which time Gelasius's insisted that Acacius's name be erased from the public records of the respected dead. Gelasius insistence and the new patriarch's refusal ushered in a new debate for this pope. He was now faced with a disagreement between church and state.

July is UV Safety Month Who is at risk from eye damage from the sun? Yes, everyone (including children) is at risk for eye damage from UV radiation that can lead to vision loss. Any factor that increases the amount of time you spend in the sun will increase your risk. People who work or play in the sun for long periods of time are at the greatest risk. The risk of sun related eye problems is higher for people who spend long hours in the sun, have had cataract surgery or have certain retina disorders, are on certain medicines, such as tetracycline, sulfa drugs, diuretics and tranquilizers that increase the eye's sensitivity to light. If you have had cataract surgery, you may be more at risk of injury from sunlight unless the artificial lens you received during surgery absorbs UV rays. Please consult your Ophthalmologist or Optometrist, if you have concerns.
