CENTENNIAL NOTES

The Sisters of the Blessed Sacrament maintained very detailed notes about the happenings at Our Lady of Lourdes Church and School. The following Centennial Notes are taken from these annual chronicles.

- On October 28, 1951 Bishop Fulton J. Sheen preached at the ten o'clock Mass. "His talk was very spiritual and inspiring"
- March 26, 1963, the parish and the Sisters learned that the Archdiocese has purchased the parish from the Society of African Missions; Fr. McKeever left the Society to join the archdiocese and continued to serve Lourdes.
- April 25, 1963, Archbishop Hallinan ordained Rev. William E. Calhoun, a convert and a member of Our Lady of Lourdes, as the first African American priest in the Archdiocese.

Centennial Note

About the Centennial Logo: The centennial logo was designed by Robert Evans (parishioner), Principal, Times3 Graphic Design. The logo uses Our Lady of Lourdes blue and gold colors, traditionally associated with the Virgin Mary. A cross shape is centered within the four quadrants, and a subtle kente pattern referencing Lourdes' African-American roots appears in the gold quadrants. The dates of the founding year and centennial year are overlaid on the squares.

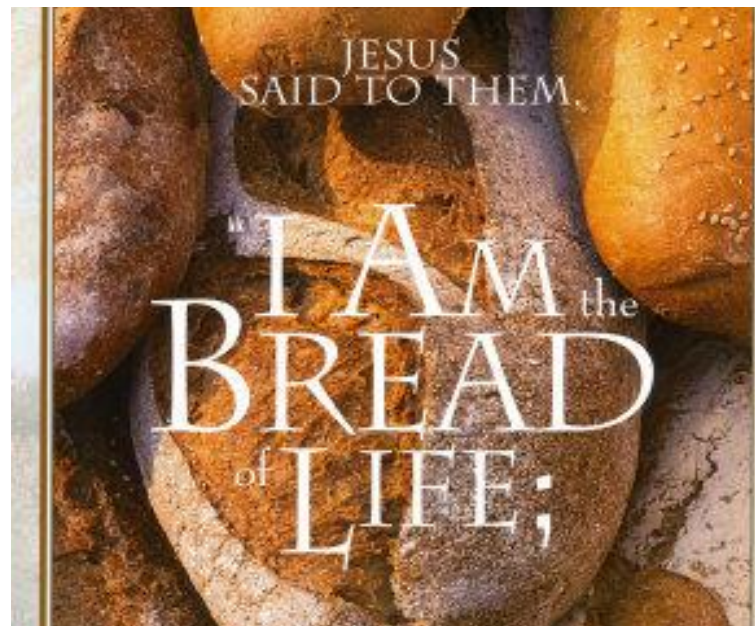

National Immunization Awareness Month is the perfect time to promote immunizations and remind family, friends, and coworkers to get caught up on their shots. Immunizations (or vaccinations) aren't just for babies and young kids. We all need shots to help protect us from serious diseases and illness. Everyone age 6 months and older needs a seasonal flu shot every year. Here are some other shots people need at different ages: Young children: Children under age 6 get a series of shots to protect against measles, polio, chicken pox, and hepatitis. Pre-teens and teens: ✓ Pre-teens need shots at age 11 or 12 to help protect them from tetanus, diphtheria, whooping cough, meningitis, and HPV (human papillomavirus). ✓ Teens need a booster shot at age 16 to help protect them from meningitis. Adults: ✓ All adults need a booster shot every 10 years to protect against tetanus and diphtheria. ✓ People age 65 or older need a one-time pneumonia shot. ✓ Talk to your doctor or nurse about which shots you and your family need.
