*Henriette Delille – Servant of Servants
1812-1862*

We thank God that Henriette Delille refused to accept the requirements of her day! We thank God that she was a woman willing to seek out only what God called her to do.

Henriette Delille was born in New Orleans in 1812 to a free black woman, Marie Joseph Diaz (called Pouponne) and a wealthy white French businessman, Jean Baptiste Delille-Sarpy. Her parents were never married, as it was illegal for interracial marriages to exist in the United States. Henriette was expected to help her mother with the special herbs and bandages. In this role she saw many slaves who had been beaten by their masters and other whites. She couldn't believe that one person should have such power over another, but she was happy to offer whatever care possible. She did not know it, but her medical skills would come in handy as she altered the plans already in motion for her future.

About the Centennial Logo: The centennial logo was designed by Robert Evans (parishioner), Principal, Times3 Graphic Design. The logo uses Our Lady of Lourdes blue and gold colors, traditionally associated with the Virgin Mary. A cross shape is centered within the four quadrants, and a subtle kente pattern referencing Lourdes' African-American roots appears in the gold quadrants. The dates of the founding year and centennial year are overlaid on the squares.

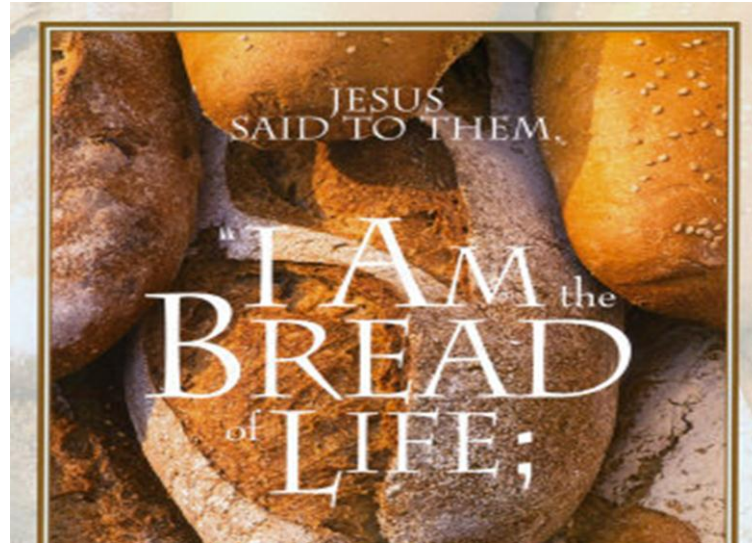

Immunizations (or vaccinations) aren't just for babies and young kids. We all need shots to help protect us from serious diseases and illness. Everyone age 6 months and older needs a seasonal flu shot every year. Here are some other shots people need at different ages: Young children: Children under age 6 get a series of shots to protect against measles, polio, chicken pox, and hepatitis. Pre-teens and teens: ✓ Pre-teens need shots at age 11 or 12 to help protect them from tetanus, diphtheria, whooping cough, meningitis, and HPV (human papillomavirus). ✓ Teens need a booster shot at age 16 to help protect them from meningitis. Adults: ✓ All adults need a booster shot every 10 years to protect against tetanus and diphtheria. ✓ People age 65 or older need a one-time pneumonia shot. ✓ Talk to your doctor or nurse about which shots you and your family need.
