## Saints and Holy People of African Descent ~ St. Pantaenus - (c. 140-c.200) Head of the catechetical school of Alexandria, Egypt

Pantaenus (c. 140-c.200 A.D.) is remembered for having improved significantly the reputation of the Alexandrian catechetical school that he headed in approximately 180. Little else is known about this great educator. None of his works are extant. Some reputable sources claim that he may have been born at Sicily rather than Alexandria.

One of Pantaenus's students, St. Clement of Alexandria, wrote glowingly of his teacher. The historian Eusebius describes Pantaenus as a man of "great learning, ardent and zealous in the preaching of the word." St. Jerome reported that Pantaenus was a missionary, perhaps either to India, Southern Arabía, Yemen, or Ethiopia. It seems that the people to whom he ministered had already received St. Matthew's Gospel from the apostle St. Bartholomew.
