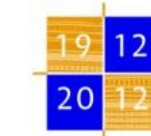

Centennial Note

About the Centennial Logo: The centennial logo was designed by Robert Evans (parishioner), Principal, Times3 Graphic Design. The logo uses Our Lady of Lourdes blue and gold colors, traditionally associated with the Virgin Mary. A cross shape is centered within the four quadrants, and a subtle kente pattern referencing Lourdes' African-American roots appears in the gold quadrants. 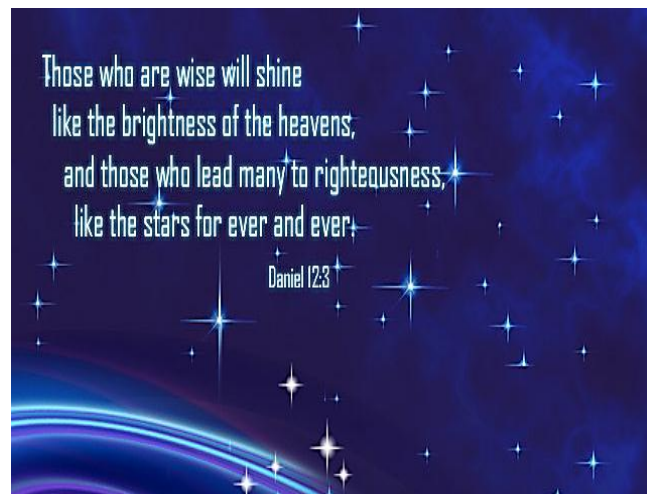

Social Action Factoid III Theme: The Death Penalty Application of the death penalty is as consistent as a lightning strike. Issues of race and class play a large part in determining who get on death row. Those convicted of killing white victims are 4.5 times more likely to be sentenced to death than those convicted of killing black victims. 80% of those accused of crimes cannot afford their own attorney, yet funding for public defenders has been repeatedly slashed in Georgia in recent years.
