AN UNLIKELY CONTRIBUTOR

From the outset of his life, it seemed unlikely that Joshua Bishop would ever become a writer for a Catholic newspaper. As the 11th Circuit Court of Appeals noted in its recent ruling on his case, the story of Bishop's horrific childhood brought tears to the eyes of some of the jurors and others in the courtroom for his death-penalty trial.

Born to an alcoholic and drug-addicted mother unable even to identify his father, young Joshua was repeatedly abandoned and placed in foster homes. Described as "affectionate, sweet, kind, and well-mannered" when he was a boy, Joshua insisted on returning to his mother's care, even when she took him and his older brother to live with her in cars and under a bridge. His upbringing took its toll. Growing dependent on drugs himself, Joshua began to experience what the court called "intermittent explosive disorder." In one fit of violence, he killed a man he believed had assaulted his mother, the first of the two murders which led him to Georgia's Death Row.

"I LOVE YOU, JOSHUA"

None of this background information made its way into Joshua Bishop's feature article, "Remembering Father Austin Fogarty," which appeared in the *Georgia Bulletin* early in February. Instead, Bishop focused on the recently-deceased Irish priest who regularly visited Georgia Diagnostic Prison to offer mass and counsel the inmates. In his moving tribute, Bishop explains how he and his fellow inmates came to rely on Father Austin's care. "Lots of us," he reminds his readers, "did not have a father to teach us things about treating our fellowman with love and respect. Father Austin loved us. He would tell each one. 'I love you, Joshua.' 'I love you, Lenny.' 'I love you, Warren.'" As a result, says the Death Row inmate, the priest "was like this big heart that took in all our pain."

GOD IS IN EVERY PERSON'S LIFE

Father Austin's approach to Georgia's Death Row inmates is right in line with what Pope Francis has called his own "dogmatic certainty"—namely, "God is in every person's life." As the pope sees it, "Even if the life of a person has been a disaster, even if it is destroyed by vices, drugs or anything else—God is in this person's life." For that reason, "You can, you must try to seek God in every human life. Although the life of a person is a land full of thorns and weeds, there is always a space in which the good seed can grow." Father Austin helped that seed to grow in Joshua Bishop.

FEAR ONLY THE THINGS LEFT UNDONE

Following Catholic teaching, Father Austin shared with the inmates his own opposition to capital punishment. But, as Joshua Bishop writes, he also reminded them that "God has power over the men who prepare us for execution. So we should show love to them and let God speak to them through our actions." Following this guidance, Bishop resolved not to fear death but "to fear only the things left undone. Take care of your heart, love others, and have your spirit clean from any hate or anger for the laws of man." Speaking of Fr. Austin's heart, Bishop concludes, "I will never forget how his love touched me."
