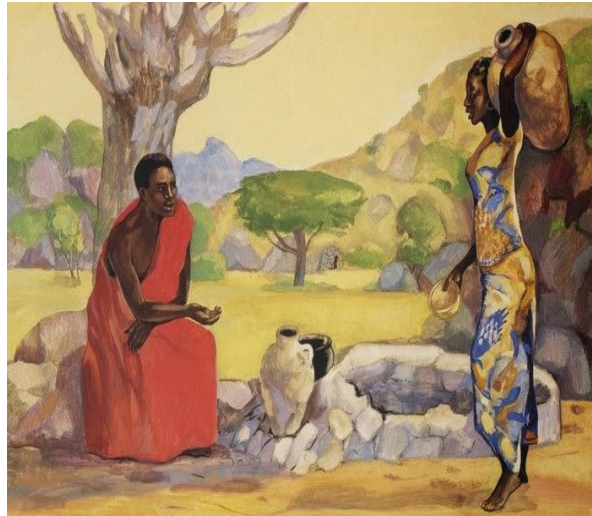

This month's is on forgiveness, a gesture of great significance for all of us in this season of Lent.

March Is National Colorectal Cancer Awareness Colorectal cancer is cancer of the colon or rectum. It's as common in women as it is in men. Colorectal cancer ranks as the No. 2 killer amongst all cancers that affect both men and women in the United States. Colorectal cancer affects all racial and ethnic groups, is most often found in those who 50 and older, and African Americans. This year, over 143,360 people will be diagnosed with colorectal cancer and an estimated 51,690 will die of the disease. With certain types of screening, this cancer can be prevented by removing polyps (grape-like growths on the wall of the intestine) before they become cancerous. Several screening tests detect colorectal cancer early, when it can be more easily and successfully treated. Prevention of this disease includes: maintaining a healthy diet, smoking cessation, limiting alcohol consumption, eating fruits, vegetables and whole grains, reducing consumption of red meat and eliminating processed meat.
