Saint Anthony heard the voice of God calling him to a more disciplined life. He sold everything he had and willingly entered a solitary and monastic life in the desert outside Thebes in Egypt. Although Anthony was not the first monk to reject all wealth and human relations to embrace a life of solitude and prayer, he is referred to as the founder of Christian monasticism because he further defined what is expected in the monastic life. Throughout his years of torment, fasting, labor and solitude, Anthony continued to exude happiness and peace and extend charity to all who saw him. He acted as a spiritual guide, was a visionary, opened monasteries and performed many miracles. Anthony's years of monastic life lasted until the year 365 when this saintly monk returned to his creator at the age of 105.
