LOURDES BOOK CLUB Join in for a book discussion on Saturday, August 22, 2015 at Panera at Emory Village at 7 p.m. Our book selection is *Kinder Than Solitude: A Novel* by Yiyun Li. Moving back and forth in time, between America today and China in the 1990s, *Kinder Than Solitude* is the story of three people whose lives are changed by a murder one of them may have committed. When they were young back in China, they were involved in a mysterious incident in which a friend of theirs was poisoned. Grown up, the three friends are separated by distance and personal estrangement. Two live in the United States and one still lives in China. All three are haunted by what really happened in their youth, and by doubt about themselves. Brilliantly written, a breathtaking page-turner, *Kinder Than Solitude* resonates with provocative observations about human nature and life. Yiyun Li unfolds this remarkable story, even as she explores the impact of personality and the past on the on the shape of a person’s present and future. “What makes [*Kinder Than Solitude*] so vivid is its humanity. . . .
