Kathleen O'Connor received her doctorate degree from Princeton Theological Seminary and is the William Marcellus McPheeters Professor of Old Testament, Emerita, at Columbia Theological Seminary. Previously, she taught at the Maryknoll School of Theology, Ossining, NY. As a professor, she frequently teaches in local churches and community groups. She has also taught courses in in Central America, Thailand, Japan and Ireland.

In her role as a scripture scholar, Dr. O'Connor has studied and written extensively on the relationship between trauma and how the prophet Jeremiah addressed profound suffering, *Jeremiah: Pain and Promise* (Fortress, 2011). Some of her other works include *Lamentation and Tears of the World* (Orbis Press, 2002), *Job* (Liturgical Press, 2013 and *The Wisdom Literature* (Liturgical Press, 1990). Dr. O'Connor is an active member of Our Lady of Lourdes Catholic Church in Atlanta.

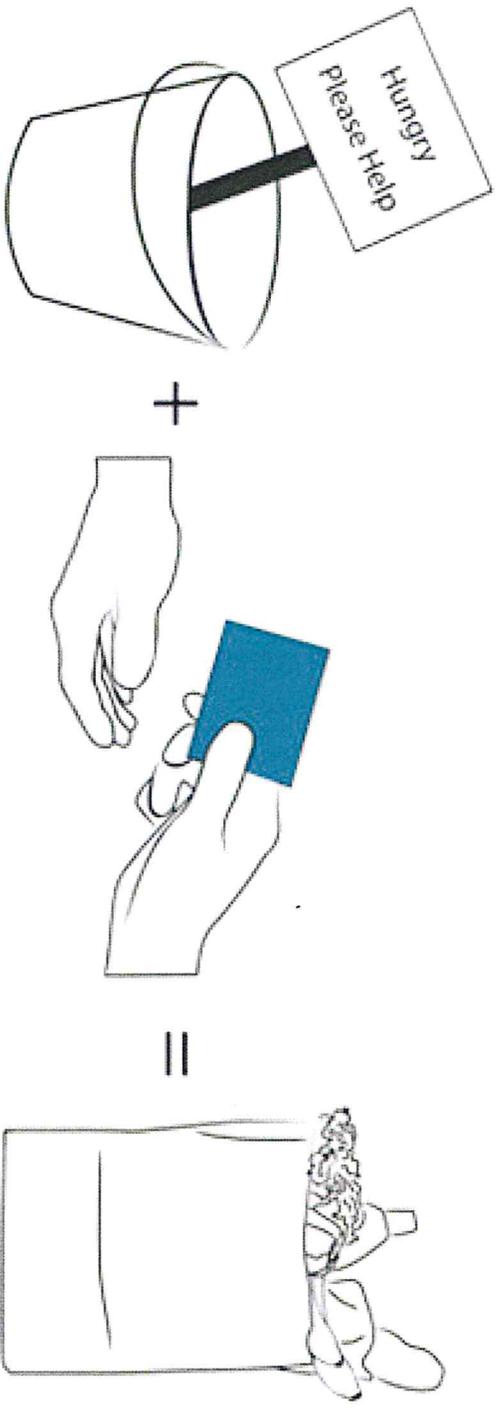
