Bread Ministry Packaging

The bread should be Hoagie Style no cut -wheat or white. Publix or Kroger (Earthgrains 6 pack), Sam's and Costco (36 count) are just some of the places you usually can find them.

The church office has put together a pre-packaged large zip-lock bag that consists of all the materials you will need to package the bread:

- Ribbons (5PM -18 count; 8AM 18 count; 10AM 36 count)
- Visitor Cards
- Labels
- Bags
- 12PM Mass uses overflow from 5PM, 8AM and 10AM Masses that is why there is no coverage except for the 5th Sunday of the month.

The bags are labeled with the Mass date and time; what I am asking of each of you or your volunteers is to pick up the pre-package bag the week that you are scheduled to prepare the bread before Friday by 6PM. This way I can be assured that bread will be available to accommodate our guest for the weekend and will also allow me to send a reminder if the bag is not picked up.

If you can **ONLY** pick up the bag on Saturday, the Visitors Bread box is located in Theresa Bowen's office (across from Lisa's office) in a blue box labeled "Visitor Bread."
