Dominicans Conclude 800th Jubilee Evening Prayer Series

With Celebration of St. Martin de Porres on November 3

Brother Joseph Paul Albin, O.P. will be the featured preacher during Evening Prayer for St. Martin de Porres – the patron of the Southern Dominican Province – at 7PM on Thursday, November 3, 2016 at Our Lady of Lourdes Parish (25 Boulevard N.E., Atlanta). Again featuring the Lourdes music ministry, the event marks the conclusion of the yearlong series honoring the Order of Preacher in its 800th Jubilee Year.

A student brother interning at Our Lady of Lourdes and living with the Atlanta community of friars, Brother Joseph Paul is involved in many of the justice and outreach ministries of the parish, including Lourdes Lunch which feeds the hungry twice weekly, Eracism which fosters interracial dialogue, elementary school tutoring, religious education and young adult ministry. Brother Joseph Paul is a student at Aquinas Institute of Theology in St. Louis, Mo., and a former veteran campus minister at Loyola University in New Orleans. He has already traveled widely as a Dominican friar, serving last summer in Kenya and Burkina Faso with Catholic Relief Services.

The Dominican friars in the Archdiocese of Atlanta – who are serving at the Emory University Catholic Center and at Our Lady of Lourdes – are taking part in the worldwide celebration of the Jubilee 800th anniversary of the Order of Preachers with a series of sung Evening Prayer and preaching events honoring four emblematic Dominican saints and featuring the Our Lady of Lourdes choir. St. Thomas Aquinas was honored in January, St Catherine of Siena in April, and St. Dominic in August.
