BE AN EFFECTIVE ADVOCATE

What's the Most Effective Way to Contact Your Legislator?

Legislators and other elected officials hear very little feedback from their constituents. Being contacted by even a few voters is often enough to mold or shift a policymaker's stance on an issue.

Should You Write, Call or E-Mail?

The experts say in order of importance:

- Personal visit with the legislator or a staffer (*Sen. Renee Unterman indicates that this is the most effective.*)
- Handwritten short personal letter
- Word-processed short personal letter
- Phone call and speaking directly to legislator or staff person (leaving your opinion with the reception staffers is good, too)
- Personal letter sent by fax
- E-mail (last on list, but still effective--especially if official receives a massive number of e-mails)

In all cases, it's most effective if the legislator is hearing from a constituent. Legislators really want to know the people in their district . . . they want to know their voters.

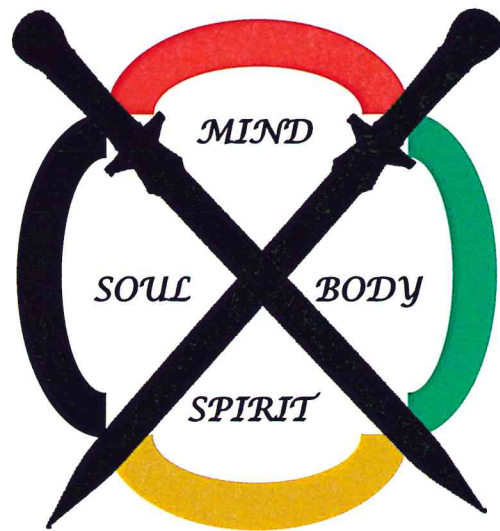
