



**SEPTEMBER IS PROSTATE CANCER AWARENESS MONTH:** Prostate Cancer is the most common cancer in men, no matter of race or ethnicity. It is the second most common cause of death from cancer among White, African American, American Indian / Alaska Native, and Hispanic men. What are the symptoms of prostate cancer?
