When Puerto Rican laborer Juan Meléndez-Colón was picked up in Pennsylvania and accused of the murder of a man he had never seen, he assumed he would soon be released. Instead, he was extradited to Florida, put on trial, and in less than a week sentenced to death on the testimony of unreliable witnesses. With limited English and few resources. Meléndez languished in prison for almost 18 years until the fortuitous discovery of the real killer's taped confession finally led to his exoneration.

Today Juan Meléndez serves as an activist for Witness to Innocence, a group of former death row prisoners and their loved ones who seek to end capital punishment by publicizing stories of wrongful convictions. In early April, Meléndez shared his story at Immaculate Heart of Mary parish in Atlanta, where he emphasized not only the horrors facing inmates awaiting execution but also the redemptive grace which allows humanity to flourish even in such adverse conditions.

#### "I DON'T WANT TO DIE!"

According to the Death Penalty Information Center, there have been 165 exonerations of death row inmates since 1973. But as Juan Meléndez pointed out, even those guilty of the crimes for which they are executed have often become very different persons by the time of their death. His fellow inmates on Florida's death row taught him to read, write, and speak English proficiently. As these friends were led off to be executed, Meléndez recoiled at his inability to save the lives of men he had learned to love.

Under such conditions, Meléndez even planned to commit suicide, bribing a trustee to supply him with a rope. But then he had a vivid dream about the freedom and love he had enjoyed as a child frolicking on the beach in Puerto Rico, and he thanked God for that grace as he awoke shouting, "I don't want to die!" Today he is convinced that it was the prayers of his mother, a Catholic deeply devoted to the Virgin of Guadalupe, which brought him through the ordeal.

#### SIGNS OF HOPE IN GEORGIA

The death penalty is steadily declining in the United States. For four years now, fewer than 30 executions have taken place, less than a 1/3 the number just 20 years before. In 2018, just 40 people were sentenced to death, compared to 294 twenty years earlier.

But in the 30 states which still impose capital punishment, including Georgia, abolition remains a contentious partisan issue. In March, however, a truly bipartisan group of Georgia legislators, led by a GOP representative from Snellville, introduced an abolition bill they hope to see debated in the next legislative session. As Juan Meléndez says, that is one heavenly dream he still longs to see fulfilled.


