St. Dymphna (d. 620), according to tradition, was born the daughter of Damon, a pagan king of Ireland. Early in her life she became a Christian, and was secretly baptized. After dodging two misguided attempts of proposal of marriage from her father, he drew his sword and cut off her head. Shortly after her death, five mentally ill individuals wandered to the countryside where she was killed, and slept the night there, only to awaken cured. She has since been invoked as the patron of those suffering from nervous, mental, and Spiritual afflictions.

Lord, our God, you graciously chose St. Dymphna as patroness of those afflicted with mental and nervous disorders and Spiritual afflictions. She is thus an inspiration and a symbol of charity to the thousands who ask for her intercession. We beg You, Lord, to hear the prayers of St. Dymphna on our behalf. Grant all those for whom we pray patience in their sufferings and resignation to your divine will. Please fill them with hope, and grant them the relief and cure they so much desire. 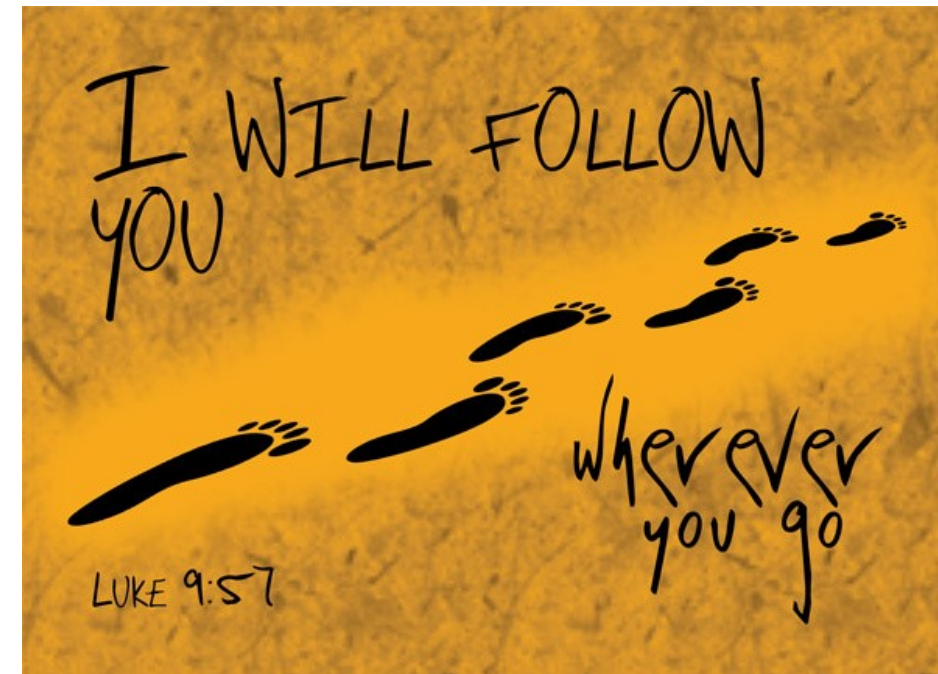
