EMAIL PHISHING SCAMS are getting more sophisticated, using familiar sender names and other information to lower their targets' defenses and make them more likely to become victims. Be alert to potential scams via email and texts especially those that solicit donations (in gift card form) and requests for payment. When you get a suspicious email, resist the false sense of urgency to take action immediately. Make sure the email is from a legitimate domain. Verify the request by phone or by initiating an email to the person. Do not click on links in suspicious emails. Verify that they are correct by opening the web page in a separate browser window or hovering over the link to check the url.




