**PULLING BACK THE CURTAIN: THE MEDICALIZATION OF EXECUTIONS**: Georgia Catholics Against the Death Penalty and Georgians for Alternatives to the Death Penalty are proud to present *Pulling Back the Curtain*, a webinar series on the death penalty. Throughout this series, we will examine the facts and myths of the death penalty in light of the curtain of secrecy the state draws around this process. 
