
AROUND THE ARCHDIOCESE

THE CATHEDRAL OF CHRIST THE KING (CTK) is a thriving parish serving close to 6,000 families in Atlanta. The cathedral was founded in 1936 and became the cathedral of the Archdiocese of Atlanta in 1956. Currently, CTK serves the parish celebrating three daily Masses Monday – Friday, nine weekend Masses and over 100 ministries. The database coordinator is a full-time (40 hours/week) position that reports to the controller of the cathedral. This role oversees the parish database and ensures accuracy and thoroughness of the data, including but not limited to, member data and financial gifts data. 


