YOU ARE INVITED TO ATTEND ANNUAL AQUINAS DAY LECTURE, on Thursday, January 30 at Candler's Aquinas Center of Theology, Pitts Lecture Hall -1531 Dickey Drive, Atlanta, GA 30322. The topic for this year's Lecture is "This Here is Paradise, But You Can't Come In: Canonizing Julia Greeley, Denver's Black Angel of Charity". This lecture explores the life and legacy of Servant of God, Julia Greeley, a formerly enslaved woman and candidate for sainthood in the Roman Catholic Church. Born into slavery between 1833-1848, Julia rose to prominence in the 1890s for her charitable work among Denver's impoverished families and firefighters. Despite experiencing physical disabilities, Julia became known for her nightly walks throughout the city, distributing food, clothing, and supplies to white families too proud to accept her aid in the light of day. In 2016, the Church officially opened her cause for canonization, and if successful, she could become the first African American saint canonized by the Vatican. Professor Williams reconstructs Julia's life story from the limited archival sources that remain and considers how local histories of Catholicism influence and are influenced by the global dynamics of Roman Catholic tradition. The Afternoon Lecture will be offered in -person and as a webinar. Registration is required for this hybrid event.




