2025 GOOD FRIDAY PILGRIMAGE: The 44th annual Good Friday Pilgrimage, urban stations of the cross, sponsored by the Roman Catholic Archdiocese of Atlanta's Justice and Peace Ministries will take place Friday, April 18, 8:45am-12:00pm. This walking prayer is a moving experience that includes scripture readings, reflections and music as we remember the passion of Christ and the social injustices in our world today. The Georgia Promise Scholarship is a new program that empowers families to pursue educational programs through nonpublic schooling, including private schools. Families of some public-school students in K-12 can receive \$6,500 per eligible student (administrative fee may apply) to help with school expenses such as tuition, school supplies and transportation. All archdiocesan Catholic schools are accepting the Georgia Promise scholarship for the 2025-26 school year. Scholarship applications are being accepted March 1 – April 15. 
